TEMAGAMI UPDATE #6 on COVID-19

March 25, 2020

The Municipality of Temagami is continually monitoring COVID-19 and is working closely with the Timiskaming Health Unit and community partners to take preventative measures and respond appropriately.

To all permanent and seasonal residents of Temagami, please avoid any UNNECESSARY TRAVEL during this time of global pandemic.

In our community we have access to: groceries, pharmaceuticals, household supplies, fuel, banking, postal services, takeout restaurants, an LCBO and various construction trades. The option for delivery is available for some of these services.

The safety of our community is of the utmost importance. If you have been to an affected area, had contact with an affected person or have developed any symptoms within the last 14 days, YOU ARE LEGALLY REQUIRED to self-isolate. Please do the responsible thing and call someone you know for help.

For the safety of our frontline workers you must be honest about where you have been, who you've been in contact with and how you are feeling when communicating with our Health and Emergency Services Providers.

The Province of Ontario has published the list of essential services that are permitted to continue operations. If you are not sure if your business is an essential service, please call the Province at 1-888-444-3659.

Please find ways to keep in constant communication, at a distance, with your loved ones, via telephone or electronically. If you know a senior, vulnerable person or persons with a compromised immune system that lives alone or may not have the local family support available, please contact them via telephone or electronically, to ensure they are ok.
