Being a by-law to authorize the boriowing of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)

WHEREAS Section 329 (1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 249, provides that a council may by by-law, either before or after the passing of the by-law for inposing the rates for the current year, authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note such si ms as the council may deem necessary to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Improvement District of Temagami has not borrowed any sum or sums by way of promissory note during the year 1970.

AND WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Corporation of the Improvement District of Temagami deem it necessary to borrow by way of promissory note the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to meet, until the taxes arc collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year;

NOW THEREFORE The Board of Trustees of the Corporation of the Improvement District of Temagami ENACTS AS FOLLOWS: 1. The Chairman and the Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation of the Improvement District of Temagami to borrow from time to time, by way of promissory note from <u>The Bank of Nova Scotia, Temagami a sum or sums</u>, not exceeding in the aggregate Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to meet the current expenditures of the Corporat .on for the year <u>1970</u> and to give on behalf of the Corporation to phe bank a promissory note or notes, duly signed and sealed with the seal of the Corporation of the Improvement District of Temagami, for the monies so borrowed with interest (which may be paid in advance or otherwise) at a rate not exceeding <u>8%</u> per annum.

2. All sums borrowed pursuant to this by-law shall, with interest thereon, be a charge on thw whole of the revenue of the

of the Corporation for the current year as and when such revenues are received.

3. The Secretary-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all the monies collected and received either on account or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year or from any other source which may be lawfully applied for such purpose.

4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect uponthe day which it receives the approval o the Department of *f*Municipal Affairs of Ontario.
