BY-LAW No, 70-52

Being a By-law to provide for the licensing of Charity, or Religious Organizations to conduct Bingo Lotteries, Raffle Lotteries, or Lottery schemes held at bazaars, within the Improvement District of Temagami.

WHEREAS, His Honour the lieutenant-Governor of Ontario, under authority of Section 179 A of The Criminal Code has, by order-in-council No. 274/70, named muricipal councils as agents to issue licences authorizing any charitable or religious organization to conduct and manage a bingo lottery, a raffle lottery or a lottery scheme held at a bazaar in accordance with the requirements contained in such ortjer-in-council

AND WHEREAS, the said order-ir-council further provides that a municipal council may set and charge fees for the issuing of licenses, provided the fees charged de not exceed such limits as may be prescribed by the Minister of financial and Commercial Affairs:

AND WHEREAS the said Municipc 1 Act provides that the councils of all municipalities may pa^s by-laws to appoint such officers and servants as may be necessary for the purpose of the Corporation

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CORPORATION OF THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF TEMAGAMI ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Secretary-treasurgr of The Improvement District of Temagami hereby is appointed as lottery licensing officer for the Improvement District of Temagami.
- 2. That each such lottery licensing officer shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council and shall exercise all the authority, powers and rights and Shall perform all the duties and obligations which, by statute or ty-laws, are or may be conferred or imposed upon the lottery licensing officer and any other duties that may be imposed by cduncil.

3. That the fees applicable to the issue or licenses as above recited, shall be as follows

BINGO LOTTERIES

(a) for single occasion.

(b) for a series of occasions

The same schedule as enumerated in Section "A" times the number of occasions; but in no case shall the fee exceed \$100.00.

4. That all the terms and conditions as required by the Department of Financial and Commercial Affairs, Province of Ontario as enumerated in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law, be incorporated as requisite to issuance of any lottery license.

SCHEDULE A

TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH

THE LOTTERY LICENCE IS ISSUED

It is a condition bf each licence that.

- (a) the licence© shall comply with sections 179 anc^ 1 79A of the Grimma Code of Canada;
- (b) the licencee shall comply with all the terms and provisions set out in the application for licence;
- -(c) the licencee sKali maintain all funds raised in a separate account < ind shall maintain such records for such period of time as may be prescribed by the Minister;
- (d) the gross receipts derived from the lottery shall be used for the charit ible or religious object or purpose as set out by the Olicenceejh.tKe application for licence, less the cost of the prizes awe rded and such reasonable and necessary administrative expenses actually incurred in the management and conduct of the lottery, provided the expenses do not exceed such limits as may be prescribed by the Minister;
 - (e) such officers as the municipal council or the Minister may appoint, ar d all Peace Officers shall, at all reasonable times, have direct and unencumbered access to enquire into the nature, management and conduct of the proceedings for which the licence hbs been granted, either prior to, during, or after t >e conclusion of such proceedings;
 - (f) the licencee shall conduct or allow 10. be conducted only the type of jame or games provided in the application and the licence,-
 - (g) the licencee shall produce the licence upon demand;
 - (h) the licencee shall submit to the licencing authority, not later than 30 days after the holding of each licenced lottery/ a written report showing,
 - (i) the Jatgl.grass receipts.deriving from the lottery,
 - (ii) the total value of all prizes actually awarded,
 - (iti) an itemized listing of the administrative costs actually incurred n th\$ management and conduct of such lottery,
 - (iv) the total of cash proceeds donated for charitable or religious purposes as set forth' in the application of the licencee, and the name and address of the payee.

Each raffle lottery shall also be subject to the following additional term; and conditions:

- (a) each individual raffle lottery must have a licence;
- (b) the winners or winners shall be determined and publicized in the mat ner set out in the application;
- (c) the charitable or religious organization managing and conducting the licenced raffle shall,
- (i) indicate on the face of the tickets the name and address of the or ganization, the location, the date, the time at which the draw is to be held, the number and nature of the prizes to he awarded, the number of the ticket, and the name of the printer,
 - (ii) provide^for the consecutive numbering of tickets,
 - (iii) retain all unsold tickets and counterfoils of sold tickets for a period of not less than 90 days from the date of the draw, and produce them to a Peace Officer or such other perion as the municipal council or the Minister may appoint,
 - (iv) indicate in its application the number of tickets Jo be printed fc \blacksquare sale.,,

NOTE:

A licencee shall noti '

(a) use the services of a person or organization to conduct and manage the lottery on its behalf, for. a fee or other valuable

^^(b) permit the pyramiding of games;

- (c) permit games of a type or kind known as razzle dazzle, roll down, hre§ card monte,. punch bqprd, coin table,_xor any dice games;
- (d) in the case of a licenced lottery type scheme at a bazaar, offer any ^rize having a value in excess of \$100 or charge in excess of F:fty (50) cents for a chance to secure a prize.
