THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 78-20

Being a by-law to regulate the use of grease-traps by restaurants, hotels and motels that is or shall be connected to the low-pressure sewer system in the Old Townsite of Temagami.

WHEREAS paragraph 71 of Section 354 of The Municipal Act being Chapter 284, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, as amended, provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities for making any other regulations for sewage or drainage that may be deemed necessary for sanitary purposes; •

NOW THEREFORE, The Corporation of the Township of Temagami enacts that each restaurant, hotel or motel with dining room that is or shall be connected to the low-pressure sewer system in the Old Townsite of Temagami shall have a grease-trap installed to the specifications of drawing No. 9.3.2 attached entitled "Typical Grease-Traps", Or such other type or size of grease-trap that may be approved by the Ministry of The Environment. Furthermore the covers of the aforesaid grease-traps shall be easily removed for inspection, and the removal of accumulated grease at regular intervals by the owners of such restaurants, hotels or motels. It shall be deemed an offence under the provisions of this by-law if any owner or operator of such a restaurant, hotel or motel connected to the low-pressure sewer system in the Old Townsite of Temagami fails to remove this accumulated grease at regular intervals such that grease accumulations are discharged to the aforesaid sewer system.

PENALTIES Any owner or operator of a restaurant, hotel or motel with dining-room connected to the low-pressure sewer system in the Old Townsite of Temagami who is found guilty of an offence under the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to a penalty of an amount not exceeding three hundred (\$300.00) dollars for each offence, exclusive of costs, to be recoverable under the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act.




