
Being a by-law to authorize
the signing of an agreement
with the Government of
Ontario

WHEREAS the Corporation of The Township of Temagami
wishes to enter into agreement with the Crown for the manage-
ment of a Provincial Mobile Home Park, located within the
Township of Temagami.


BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED that the Reeve and Clerk-
Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to execute an
agreement under the seal of the Corporation of The Township
of Temagami with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario
as represented by the Minister of Northern Affairs, a copy
of which is attached as a Schedule to this by-law which pro-
vides among other things that the Corporation shall act as
the agent of the Province with respect to the management of
the Provincially-constructed mobile home park for an indefin-
ite period and may be terminated at any time by either party.

AGREEMENT

**HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN 1n right of the
Province of Ontario as represented
by the Minister of Northern Affairs
hereinafter referred to as the
"Province".**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
TENAGAMI as represented by the
Reeve of the Township, hereinafter
referred to as the "Township",**

It is understood and agreed however, that the costs of all normal municipal maintenance, for example, snowplowing, road grading, ditch cleaning, shall be borne by the Township.

5. The Province authorizes the Township to make all repu necessary for the proper maintenance of the mobile home park provided that where the costs of repairs exceeds Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), the Township undertakes to obtain the prlbr approval of the Province, whenever possible.
6. The Township agrees that the Province or 1t\$ representative shall be permitted the right of Inspection at all reasonable times for the purpose of verifying Invoices, progress reports or obtaining any Information which the Province may require.
7. Either the Province or the Township may at any time by notice 1n writing to the other suspend or terminate the whole or any part of this Agreement.
