THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 81*61

Being a by-law to assume into the Township road system the Strathcona Access Road

WHEREAS the road known as the STRATHCONA ACCESS ROAD lies wholly within the boundaries of the Township of Temagami

AND WHEREAS the Strathcona Access Road has been inspected by an official of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications and found acceptable in accordance with Circular 72-010 Case 1 with no defficiencies noted

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Natural Resources advise that it is in order for the Township to take over this road formerly under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Natural Resouces

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Corporation of the Township of Temagami assumes the road known locally as Strathcona Access Road commencing at its intersection with Kings Highway No. 11 in Strathcona Township and extending in a westerly direction running approximately parallel to Inlet Bay, Lake Temagami for a distance of approximately one point three miles (1.3) with a sixty-six foot right-of-way through crown land and various surveyed locations all within the Township of Strathcona to its termination in Strathcona Township at the easterly end of the north and south boundary line of part ane (1) of location RW two hundred and forty six (246), being known as the Strathcona Access Point on Lake Temagami.
