

Being a by-law to regulate parking on
Municipal Parking Lots.

WHEREAS Section 210(125) of the Municipal Act,
R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 302 as amended, authorizes the Council
to pass by-laws for prohibiting the parking of motor vehicles
on property owned or occupied by a municipality or any local
board thereof without the consent of the municipality or local
board, as the case may be.

AND WHEREAS Section 208 (55) of the Municipal Act
provides that by-laws may be passed for regulating, supervising
and governing the parking of vehicles on land owned or occupied
by the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this By-law:

(a) "Township" means the Corporation of the Township of
Temagami.

(b) "Motor vehicle" includes an automobile, motorcycle,
motor assisted bicycle unless otherwise indicated in this
by-law and any other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise
than by muscular power.

(c) "Park" means the standing of a motor vehicle, whether
occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the
purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading
merchandise or passengers.

(d) "Parking Lot" means the property owned or occupied
by the Township which parking is regulated by the posting
of signs or by the use of parking meters, and which lots are
more particularly described on Schedule "A" hereto and which
may be described in this by-law by reference to the lot number
shown on Schedule "A".

(e) "Parking Manager" means the person appointed by the
Township Clerk to be the Parking Manager.

PERMITS

2. (a) The Parking Manager or his authorized delegate is
hereby authorized to issue permits and to reserve parking
spaces for the purposes of permitting parking in the Parking
Lots described in this by-law and to charge therefore the
following sums:

Daily.....	\$	3.30
Weekly.....	\$	£2.00
Seasonal (June July August)	\$	150.00

(b) No person who does not hold an authorized permit
for a reserved parking space shall park a motor vehicle in
such designated reserved parking space.

3- The Parking Manager shall designate individual parking
spaces in the Parking lots.

4. Collection of fees paid to park in the Parking Lots shall
be under the control of the Parking Manager who shall keep
a proper record of same and deposit same to the credit of
the Township

5. No person shall park a motor vehicle in any aisle, entrance or exit of a parking lot.

6. Where a motor vehicle is found parked in contravention of this by-law, then such vehicle may be removed at the sole risk and expense of the owner by any Provincial Offences Officer, Peace Officer, the Parking Manager or his authorized delegate.

7- Every owner of a vehicle left parked in contravention of this by-law, notwithstanding that he was not the driver of the vehicle at the time of the contravention of the by-law, is guilty of an offence and is liable to the fine prescribed for the offence, unless at the time of the offence, the vehicle was in the possession of some person other than the owner without the owner's consent.

PENALTY 8. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable to a penalty of not more than \$50.00, exclusive of costs, and such penalty shall be recovered under the Summary Convictions Act or the Provincial Offences Act, which is applicable.

9. When a vehicle is found parked in contravention of this by-law, any officer, servant agent of the Township so finding the vehicle may issue a summons, a parking infraction notice or attach to the vehicle a parking ticket in the form of a serial numbered notice stating;

- (a) the licence number or permit of the vehicle;
- (b) the date, time and place and nature of the alleged offence;
- (c) the procedure for making payment.

10. Any servants, employees or agents, employed or appointed by the Township are hereby appointed to enforce the provisions of this by-law.

11. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed, provided that no provisions of this by-law shall be effective until the sign or signs, if any, applicable to such provision have been erected and are on display.


