

BY-LAW 90-25^

Being a by-law to adopt estimates of school rates required during the year and to strike the rate of taxation for the year 1989.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami has in accordance with the Municipal Act considered the estimates of the Timiskaming Board of Education and The Nipissing District Separate School Board and it is necessary that the following sums be raised by means of taxation for the year 1989.

Elementary Public Schools	-	\$ 777,984
Secondary Public Schools	-	\$ 642,924
Elementary Separate Schools	-	\$ 382
Secondary Separate Schools	-	\$ 349

AND WHEREAS the assessment roll made in 1989 upon which 1990 taxes are to be levied was finally revised by the Assessment Review Court.

AND WHEREAS the Assessment for each of the bodies for which is necessary to levy rates is as follows:

THEREFORE THE Council of the Township of Temagami Enacts as Follows:

1. That the estimates be adopted and the following amounts be levied therefore in the manner as set out hereinafter.

2. There shall be levied and collected upon the assessable lands, buildings and businesses within the Township of Temagami the following rates for the 1990.
