

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 91-276

BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING AREA IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
TEMAGAMI, THUS AMENDING GENERAL TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO.74-78 AS AMENDED
BY BY-LAWS 76-99, 77-17, 80-49, & 83-103

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary, in the interest of public safety,
to amend the Traffic By-Law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of
Temagami enacts as follows:

THAT Schedule #3 - Providing for "NO PARKING" be amended to include
the following:

1. On the West side of Highway 11, Temagami from a point commencing at
the south east corner of Lot 135 (Bank of Nova Scotia) southerly to
the north east corner of that portion of Fourth Avenue closed up
and described on Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 91-274

THAT the provisions of this By-Law shall become effective upon
receipt of Ministry of Transportation approval and erection of
appropriate signs.

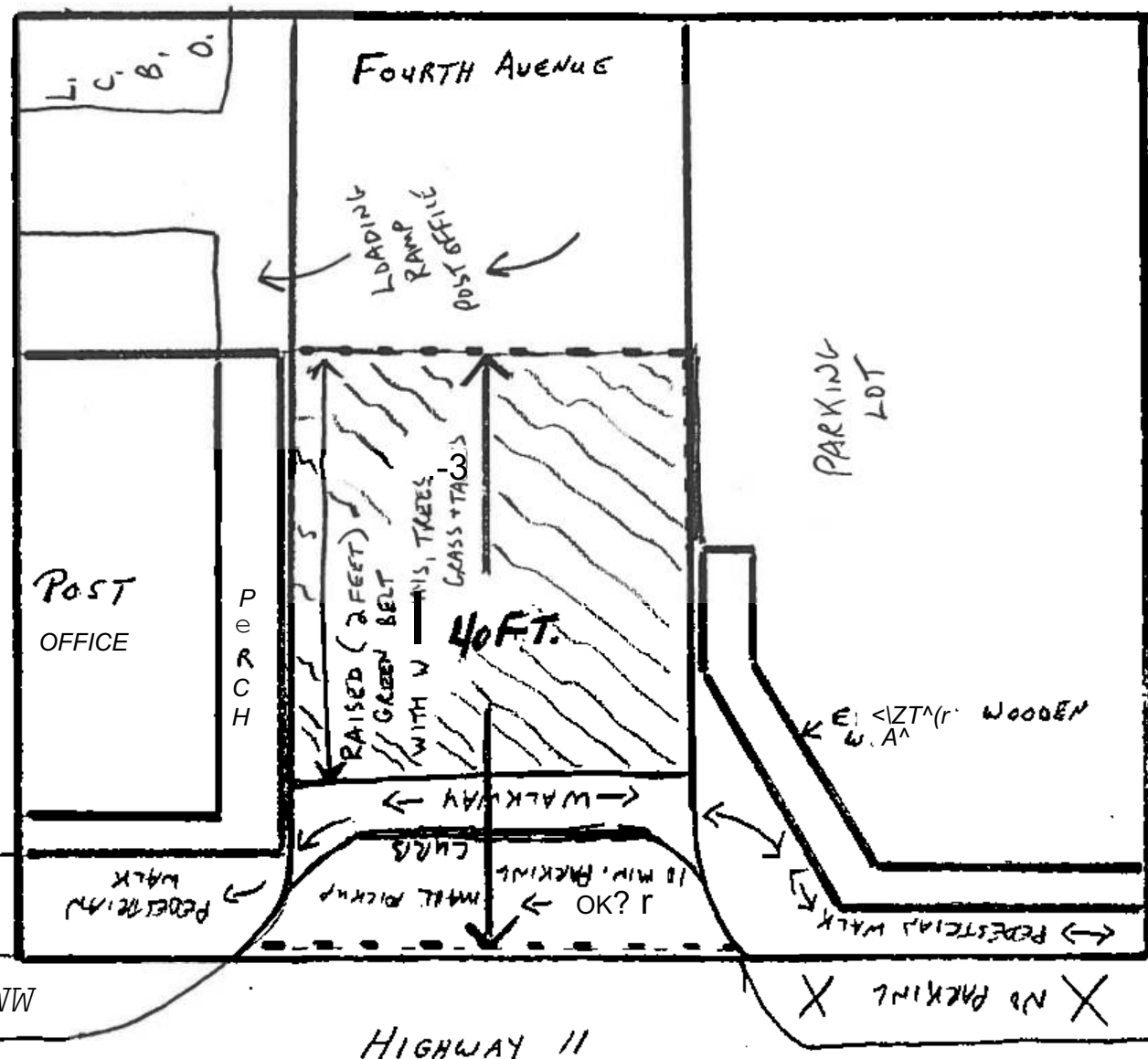

Pursuant to the Municipal Act, RSO c.302 s.298(1)(c) & 298(10) the municipality proposes to close a portion of Fourth (4th) Ave. to vehicular traffic. The point of access and means of egress for this area will be located to the south of the Temagami Foodland property.



Sec. 298(1)(c)...The Council of every municipality may pass by-laws,
(c) for stopping up any highway or part of a highway...

Sec.298(10) ...The Council may in any by-law closing a highway provide that the same shall only be closed for vehicular traffic and not for pedestrian traffic, and may provide for the erection of barricades to enforce the due observance thereof.
