CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 92-285

BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE OWNERS OF A DOG OR DOGS WITHIN THE
TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 302, Section 210, Subsection (6), authorizes By-Laws for removal of excrement left by dogs within a Municipality?

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable to regulate owners of dogs within the Township of Temagami, respecting the sanitary disposal of dog excrement.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami enacts the following:

•1. In this By-Law:

(a) Dogs shall include both female and male dogs.

(b) Dog Owner means a person who owns a dog or a person who possesses, keeps or harbours a dog for any period of time.

(c) Dog does not include a guide dog within the meaning of the Blind Persons' Rights Act or a Police Work Dog.

(d) Public Place includes a highway, public park and other municipal property.

(e) Highway means a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, place and bridge designed and intended for use by the general public for the passage of vehicles and persons.

(f) Public Park means a park, recreation area, recreation centre, play lot, playground, school ground, athletic field, beach, and any building thereon intended for or used by the general public.

(g) Municipal Property means property other than a highway or public park.

2. (a) No dog owner and no person who has control of a dog shall leave excrement deposited by the dog on or in the following premises:

i> Public place.

ii) Private property, without the consent of the owner of the premises.


(b) The dog owner or person referred to in subsection (a) shall immediately and without delay, remove the excrement and provide for its sanitary disposition.

3. Every person who contravenes Section 2(a) above is guilty of an offense and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than One Thousand (\$1,000.) exclusive of costs. Enforcement shall be pursuant to the Provincial Offenses Act 1990, Chapter and amendments thereto.


4. This By-Law shall come into force and effect on the date of passage.
