

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 92-290

Being a by-law to Impose, Levy  
and Collect Taxes, (and Soecial  
Rates) for the year 1992 for  
the Townshio of Temagami

WHEREAS Section 155 of the Municioal Act, R.S.O., 1990 as amended, provides that Councils shall levy on the whole of the assessment for real orooerty and business assessment, according to the last revised assessment roll, a sum equal to the aggregate of the sums adopted under Section 162:

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the puroose of oroviding the SUM of 5508,691.00 for the general ournoses of the Corooration of the Townshio of Temagami, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 30.575 mills on the dollar on all of the commercial and industrial real property assessment and business assessment, and 25.989 mills on all of the residential real property assessment, according to the last revised assessment roll.
2. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$43,577.00 for the collection of Garbage in the special area of the Corooration of the Township of Temagami, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 8.02 mills on the dollar on all of the Commercial and Industrial real property assessment and business assessment, and 6.43 mills on all of the residential real orooerty assessment, according to the last revised special area roll.
3. For the ouroose of providing the sum^ of 5550,826.00 for elementary public school purposes, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 35.075 mills on the dollar upon all of the commercial and industrial real orooerty assessment and business assessment of Public School suoporters, and 29.814 mills on all of the residential real orooerty assessment of Public School suoooters, accordino to the last revised assessment roll.
4. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$2,954.00 for elementary separate school purposes, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 26.1444 mills on the dollar upon all of the commercial and industrial real orooerty assessment and business assessment of Seoarate School supporters, and 22.222 mills on all of the residential real property assessment of Seoarate School supporters, according to the last revised assessment roll.
5. for the ouroose of oroviding the sum of \$487,829. for secondary school ourooses, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 31.063 mills on the dollar on all of the commercial and industrial real orooerty assessment and business assessment, and 26.404 mills on all of the residential real orooerty assessment, according to the last revised assessment roll.
6. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$2,982.00 for the Secondary Separate School purposes, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 26.392 mills on the dollar upon all of the commercial and industrial real property assessment and business assessment of searate school suoooters, and 22.433 mills on all of the residential real property assessment of searate school suoooters, according to the last revised assessment roll.

7. The amounts required to be levied and collected by this by-law shall be reduced by the amounts levied and collected by the interim tax levy authorized by By-law No. 92-282 of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami.

8. Real property taxes imposed pursuant to the provisions of this by-law shall become due and payable in two equal installments on July 31, 1992, and September 30, 1992.

9. Business taxes imposed pursuant to the provisions of this by-law shall become due and payable in two equal installments on July 31, 1992 and September 30, 1992.

10. The Tax Collector and the Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami shall mail or cause to be mailed to the address of the residence or place of business of each property or person a notice specifying the amount of taxes payable by such persons pursuant to the provisions of this by-law.

11. The taxes payable pursuant to this by-law shall be paid into the office of the Treasurer of Tax collector for the Corporation of the Township of Temagami or before the respective due dates hereinbefore set forth.

12. The Tax Collector and Treasurer are hereby authorized to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes which have become due pursuant to this by-law.

13. In default of payment of the full amount of any taxes by the respective due dates, any subsequent instalment or installments thereof shall forthwith become due and payable and, in addition, thereto, as per Section 399(3) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990, a percentage charge of 1 1/4 percent is hereby imposed as a penalty for non-payment and shall be added to any taxes as aforesaid or any instalment or part thereof remaining unpaid on the first day of each calendar month thereafter in which default continues, but not after December 31, 1992.
