BY-LAW NO. 92-298



BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP PART OF THE ORIGINAL ROAD ALLOWANCE KNOWN AS FOURTH AVENUE AS SHOWN ON PLAN M-66

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the original road allowance set out and described in Schedule A attached hereto be closed and stopped up; and the land sold to the adjoining landowner; and

WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in the Temiskaming Speaker, a newspaper published in the Town of New Liskeard; and

WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been posted up for at least one month in six of the most public places in the immediate neighbourhood of the said road allowance; and

WHEREAS the Council for the Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That upon and after the passing of this by-law all that portion of Fourth Avenue set out and described in Schedule A attached hereto be and the same is hereby closed and stopped.
- 2. All that part of the said Fourth Avenue hereinbefore described and stopped up shall be sold to the adjoining owners: William James Kitts, Ronald James Carr and Jack Vernon Erwin as tenants in common, for the sum of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00).
- 3. The Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami are hereby authorized to sign or execute such Deeds or other documents as may be necessary to effect conveyance of that part of the said road allowance hereinbefore described and which has been stopped up and closed.
