The Corporation of the Township of Temagami

By-Law No. _93-307_

BEING a By-Law to provide that a levy be made before the adoption of the estimates for the year 1993.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Temagami, pursuant to Section 399 (1) of the MUNICIPAL ACT R.S.0.1990, c. M. 45, as amended, deems it expedient to make a pre-levy;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami enacts as follows:

1) That in the year 1993, before the adoption of the estimates of the year, a levy shall be made on the whole of the assessment roll, of a sum not to exceed 50 percent of that which would be produced by applying to such assessment, the whole rate for all purposes levied in the proceeding year on residential and real property and on business assessment of public and separate school supporters.

2) The respective amount which could be raised under the provisions of paragraph 1 of this by-law is \$798/372.

3) The rate to be levied under the provisions of paragraph 1 of this bylaw to produce the amount of levy set out in paragraph 2 of this by-law is 44 mills.

4) The date for payment of taxes under this by-law shall be as follows:

first installment -	March 1,1993
second installment -	April 30,1993

5) In default of the first installment of taxes or any part thereof, by the date named therein for the payment thereof; the remaining installment or installments shall forthwith become due and payable.

6) It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer immediately after the two dates named in Paragraph 4, to collect at once by distress or otherwise, under the provisions of the Statutes and Tax Collection By-law ,in that behalf all such installments or parts thereof as shall not have been paid on or before the respective dates provided aforesaid, together with the said percentage charges as they are incurred.

7) The Clerk-Treasurer, not later than 14 days prior to the date that the first installment is due shall mail, or cause to be mailed to the address or the residence or place of business of each person, a notice setting out the tax payments required to be made pursuant to this by-law, the respective dates by which they are to be paid to avoid penalty and the particulars imposed by the by-law for late payment.

8) Taxes shall be payable to the Corporation of the Township of Temagami and shall be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer at the Township office.

9) The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept part-payment from time to time, on account, of any taxes due and to give receipt for such part-payment, provided that acceptance of any part-payment shall not effect the collection percentage charges imposed and collectable under paragraph 6 in respect to the non-payment of any installment thereof.
