

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP

OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW No. 94-348

Being a by-law to control and regulate the parking of vehicles on municipal property.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Section 210 (131) c. M.45 , provides that councils may pass by-laws to regulate and control the parking of vehicles on municipal property.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

1. That every person who parks their vehicle and or trailer on the municipal parking area servicing the Welcome Centre, the Pavilion and the Fish Hatchery is required to follow the provisions contained herein.
2. The areas designated by the map contained in Schedule A will be controlled in the following manner:

Area A and Area B are for Day Use Parking of vehicles only, trailers are not permitted. Day Use is defined as a 12 hour period of parking.

Area C is for Day Use Parking of vehicles and boat trailers. The 12 hour time limit remains the same.
3. The Corporation of the Township of Temagami will provide adequate signage to inform individuals that the Township of Temagami is the owner of the parking area and further informing of the existence of this Bylaw.
4. The Corporation of the Township of Temagami, as owner of the parking areas reserves the right to allow parking in these areas beyond the 12 hour limit if it considers conditions warrant the extension of parking rights. This consent shall be provided by the Township in writing.

PENALTY CLAUSE

5. The Corporation of the Township of Temagami reserves the right to have vehicles and trailers removed from the municipal parking area if the vehicle is parked in violation of this Bylaw without the consent of the Township.

6. The cost of and any liability associated with removing, towing and storage of vehicles that are in violation of this Bylaw shall be born by the registered owner of the vehicle or trailer. Section 326 of the Municipal Act allows for the direction of costs.

REPEAL CLAUSE

7. Where the provisions of any other by-law, resolution or action of Council are inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail.

APPROVAL CLAUSE

8. This bylaw shall come into effect when it has received third reading.
