## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

Bylaw No. 96-382

BEING A BYLAW TO ASSUME PORTIONS OF THE SHORE RESERVATION ALONG THE NORTHEAST ARM OF LAKE TEMAGAMI AS SHOWN ON PLAN M-66 AS PUBLIC HIGHWAY.

Whereas the Township is the owner of the surface rights of all streets, lanes and pathways on M-66 including the 66' Reserve north of the northeast arm of Lake Temagami (the "Reserve"); and,

Whereas Council has been approached with a request to purchase "The Pavilion", which includes parts of the Reserve; and,

Whereas by resolution 96-21 Council approves the sale of the lands known as the Pavilion including certain portions of the said Reserve as more particularly identified below; and,

Whereas Council is advised by George W. Kemp of the firm Kemp, Maille & Hamel that in order to close those portions of the Reserve and subsequently sell those portions with the sale of the "Pavilion", the proceedings must be carried under the authority of the Municipal Act; and,

Whereas Council is further advised that in order to exercise the authority conferred upon it under the Municipal Act with respect to closing the certain portions of the Reserve it must first assume those portions.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That those lands described as Part of the Shore Reservation along the Northeast Arm of Lake Temagami, Registered Plan M-66, illustrated as part of Parts 2 and 3 on Plan 36R-9430 and Part 4 and part of Part 1 onPlan 36R-10091 are hereby assumed by the Municipality as a public highway pursuant to the provisions of Section 297 (1) (a) of the Municipal Act, R.S.0.1990 C. M. 45 as amended
