

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEMAGAMI

BYLAW NO. 97-389

BEING a Bylaw to provide that a levy be made before the adoption of the estimates for the year 1997.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Temagami, pursuant to Section 399 (I) of the MUNICIPAL ACT R.S.O.1990, c. M.45, as amended, deems it expedient to make a pre-levy;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Temagami enacts as follows:

- 1) That in the year 1997, before the adoption of the estimates of the year, a levy shall be made on the whole of the assessment role, of a sum not to exceed 50 percent of that which would be produced by applying to such assessment, the whole rate for all purposed levied in the proceeding year on residential and real property and on business assessment of public and seperate school supporters.
- 2) The respective amount which could be raised under the provisions of paragraph I of this bylaw is \$585,000.
- 3) The rate to be levied under the provisions of paragraph I of this bylaw to produce the amount of levy set out in paragraph 2 of this bylaw is 38 mills.
- 4) The date of payment of taxes under this bylaw shall be as follows:

first instalment - February 27, 1997

second instalment - April 24, 1997
- 5) In default of the first instalment of taxes or any part thereof, by the date named therein for the payment thereof; the remaining instalment or instalments shall forthwith become due and payable.
- 6) It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer immediately after the two dates named in Paragraph 4, to collect at once by distress or otherwise, under the provisions of the Statutes and Tax Collection Bylaw, in that behalf all such instalments or parts thereof as shall not have been paid on or before the respective dates provided aforesaid, together with the said percentage charges as they are incurred.
- 7) The Clerk-Treasurer, not later than 14 days prior to the date that the first instalment is due shall mail, or cause to be mailed to the address or the residence or place of business of each person, a notice setting out the tax payments required to be made pursuant to this bylaw, the respective dates by which they are to be paid to avoid penalty and the particulars imposed by the bylaw for late payment.

8) Taxes shall be payable to the Corporation of the Township of Temagami and shall be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer at the Township office.


9) The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept part-payment from time to time, on account, of any taxes due and to give receipt for such part-payment, provided that acceptance of any part-payment shall not effect the collection percentage charges imposed and collectable under paragraph 6 in respect to the non-payment of any instalment thereof.


10) This Bylaw, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act, permits the incorporation of water and sewer billings to be applied to the tax billing in a manner and amount as determined by Council.

11) In default of payment of the full amount of any taxes by the respective due dates, any subsequent instalment or installations thereof shall forthwith become due and payable and, in addition a percentage charge of **15% per annum or 1 1/4% per month**, shall be levied on unpaid taxes in the manner established by Section 399 (3) of the Municipal Act.

READ a first and second time this 9th day of January , 1997.

READ a third time and finally passed this 9th day of January, 1997.
