THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BYLAW 98-429

Being a bylaw to permit the temporary use of lands within Mining Claim T-53468.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami is empowered to pass Temporary Use Bylaws to regulate the use of land pursuant to Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate to permit the temporary use of lands under Land Use Permit LTE 396 to Nortem Mining & Exploration Inc. (Ontario Inc. #1204015), described as Strathy Township Mining Claim T-53468, for Light Industrial purposes for the period of three years.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami enacts as follows:

Light Industrial Uses are permitted on the lands shown on Schedule "A" to this bylaw for a period of three years of the effective date of this Bylaw in accordance with Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13. For the purposes of this bylaw Light Industrial Uses are defined as the use of land, building or structure designed for the purpose of manufacturing, assembling, making, preparing, ornamenting, finishing, treating, altering repairing, warehousing, or storing or adapting for sale of any good, substance, article, or thing, and includes storage of building and construction equipment and materials, wholesaling, storage or shipping, lumber yards, saw mills and contractors yards. The storage of waste, which includes ashes, garbage, refuse, domestic waste, industrial waste, or municipal refuse and other such materials, is not permitted.

This Bylaw shall come into force in accordance with provisions of Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

READ A THIRD and final time and passed this <u>13</u> day of August, 1998.
