THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BYLAW No. 99-448

Being a bylaw to permit the temporary use of lands now owned by the Municipality of Temagami (the former William Milne & Sons Ltd. property).

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami is empowered to pass Temporary Use Bylaws to regulate the use of land on a temporary basis pursuant to Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

AND WHEREAS Section 23.9 of the Official Plan permits the Municipality to pass Temporary Use Bylaws;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate to permit the temporary use of lands owned by the Municipality on part of the former William Milne & Sons Ltd. property for industrial uses and display areas for three years.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami enacts as follows:

- 1. That the lands shown on Schedule "A" as being subject to this Bylaw be permitted to be used for the:
 - outdoor storage of pipeline and pipeline related materials; and
 - storage of landscaping equipment and materials within a temporary greenhouse building and on lands adjacent to such building.

The above uses shall be permitted for a period of three years of the effective date of this Bylaw in accordance with Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13.

This Bylaw shall come into force in accordance with Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13.


