BYLAW NUMBER 00-475

BEING a bylaw to authorize the naming of crown access roads for 911 purposes

WHEREAS Section 102 of the *Municipal Act* R.S.O. 1990, c M.45, provides that the council of every local municipality may pass such by-laws and make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the municipality wishes to establish names of roads to meet the implementation requirements of a 911 program for the 892 telephone exchange;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT in conjunction with the attached maps that form part of this bylaw the following names of roads be established:
 - a) Road in Sisk township leading east from Hwy. 11 toward the end residence, be called HANDLY ROAD, in recognition of long time resident Mr. Fred Handly.
 - b) Road in Sisk township leading west from Hwy. 11 past the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario sand dome at Marten River toward the end residence be called ARTHUR'S ROAD, in recognition of Arthur Arnold who built the road approximately twenty-five years ago.
 - c) Road in Sisk township leading north from Hwy. 64 past Red Cedar Lake Camp toward the end residence be called RED CEDAR ROAD, in reference to adjacent Red Cedar Lake.
 - d) Split road in Olive Township leading west from Hwy. 11 toward the end residence to the south and north to the end residence, near Ravenscroft Lodge, be called RATTLER ROAD.
 - e) Road in Olive township leading west from Hwy. 11 toward the end residence be called OLD MILL ROAD in recognition of an old saw mill that was located on this road many years ago.
 - f) Road in Olive Township leading east from Tonomo Lake Road to the end residence, be called JUMPING CARIBOU ROAD, in reference to bordering Jumping Caribou Lake.
