

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 05-599

Being a By-law with Respect to Water, Sewage and Grinder Pump Service Rates.

WHEREAS in accordance to Section 391 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, a municipality and a local board may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons,

(a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;

AND WHEREAS in accordance to Section 398 (2) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, the treasurer of a local municipality may, and upon request of a local board whose area of jurisdiction includes any part of the municipality shall, add fees and charges imposed by the municipality, or local board, respectively, under this Part to the tax roll for the following property in the local municipality and collect them in the same manner as municipal taxes:

1. In case of fees and charges for the supply of a public utility, the property to which the public utility was supplied.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami deems it expedient to enact the following:

1. That rates and charges with respect to water and sewer services are hereby set as per schedule "A" hereto attached and forming part of this by-law.
2. The provision of this by-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2005.

BE TAKEN AS READ A FIRST time on this 10th day of March, 2005.

READ A SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 10th day of March, 2005.

**WATER, SEWER AND GRINDER PUMP BY-LAW
SCHEDULE "A"
TO BY-LAW NO. 05-599
2005 SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES**

EFFECTIVE DATE:

January 1st, 2005 to December 31st, 2005 inclusive for all water, sewer and grinder pump services.

WATER, SEWAGE AND GRINDER PUMP USERS

Water only/unit Sewer only/unit Grinder Pumps only/unit

Annual \$342.00

\$160.00

\$215.00

Note: Residential Water and Sewer Services and Charges are based on one (1) unit per household. Residential Grinder Pump Services and Charges are based on the number of units per household, normally one (1).

Commercial and Industrial Water, Sewer and Grinder Pump Services and Charges are based on the same rate per unit as Residential Services and Charges and usage and number of toilets, grinder pumps, etc. are factored in.
