## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

## **BY-LAW NO. 13-1144**

## Being a by-law to appoint a Head of Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami.

WHEREAS under Subsection 10 (1) (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the Act) a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting the governance structure of the municipality and its local boards;

AND WHEREAS under Subsection 26 (1) of the Act, if a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of council, the municipality may fill the vacancy by appointing a person who has consented to accept the office if appointed;

AND WHEREAS under the Order of the Commission made under the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, effective January 1, 1998, which formed the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami, the Head of Council was given the title of Mayor;

AND WHEREAS by resolution 13-393 on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013, the Council of the Municipality of Temagami declared the Office of Mayor to be vacant;

AND WHEREAS on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013, Councillor Lorie Hunter consented to accept the office of mayor if appointed and council passed resolution 13-393 directing that Councillor Lorie Hunter be appointed as Mayor;

AND WHEREAS under section 264 of the Act, a person appointed or elected to fill a vacancy shall hold office for the remainder of the term of the person he or she replaced.

## NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Lorie Hunter is hereby appointed as Head of Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami with the title of Mayor; and
- 2. That this appointment shall remain in effect for the remainder of the current term of Council, unless otherwise declared vacant in accordance with the Act;
- 3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.

That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make 4. minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to this by-law, after the passage of the by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
