AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed By-Law 09-853 on the 25th day of June, 2009, to authorize an agreement for Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) policing services until the 31st day of December 2013; pursuant to Section 32 of which, the Parties may amend the Agreement by written agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed resolution number 13-557 on the 21st day of November 2013 to enter into an amending agreement, to extend said agreement for 2014 at the current FTE level on the new 2013 cost Recovery Formula;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement as per the Amending Agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law;
- 2. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing thereof;
- 3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

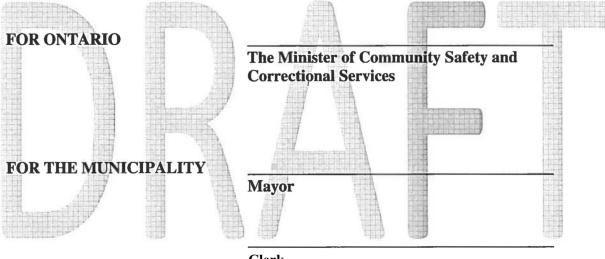
