

**THE CORPORATION OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI**

**BY-LAW NO. 14-1166**

---

**Being a by-law to amend By-law 11-1035, a by-law to delegate the powers and duties of the Head for the purpose of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act to the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami.**

---

WHEREAS the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.56, provides in subsection 49(1) that the Council of a Municipality may in writing delegate a power or duty granted or vested in the head to an officer or officers of the institution subject to such limitations, restrictions, conditions and requirements as the head may set out in the delegation;



AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Temagami passed By-law 11-1035 on the 3rd day of November, 2011, to delegate the powers and duties of the head to the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami and now deems it expedient to amend said by-law;

**NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:**

1. That section 2 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:
  2. That notwithstanding the above delegation, the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami shall ensure that Council is kept apprised of any requests made under the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, in the manner and frequency as may be directed by resolution of Council;
2. That section 3 shall be added as follows and the remaining sections shall be re-numbered accordingly:
  3. That the delegation of these powers and duties does not prevent the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami from exercising the delegated powers and duties with regard to requests that the Clerk or Chief Administrative Officer determine warrant the consideration of Council;
3. That this by-law shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof;
4. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.

BE TAKEN AS READ A FIRST time on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2014.

READ A SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2014.
