

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 14-1181


Being a by-law to authorize the use of vote by mail for the 2014 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that a council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail or by telephone, that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote.

AND WHEREAS Council by resolution 14-086, passed on the 20th day of February 2014, deems it appropriate and in the public interest to use a vote by mail method in the 2014 Municipal Election;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the alternative voting method of "Vote by Mail" is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held in 2014.
2. That in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, the Municipal Clerk shall establish procedures, rules and forms for the authorized alternative voting method.
3. That no proxy voting provisions shall be applicable for the Municipal Election conducted in accordance with this by-law.
4. That no advance voting provisions, other than Ballot Return Stations provided for in the procedures established in paragraph 2 of this by-law, shall be applicable for the Municipal Election conducted in accordance with this by-law.
5. That the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the necessary agreements to provide for the authorized alternative voting method.
6. That any person, corporation or trade union guilty of corrupt practices or contravening the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 or the procedures and rules as established in paragraph 2 of this by-law may be prosecuted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.
7. That By-law 2010-915 and any other previous by-laws, or parts thereof, that provide for alternate voting methods are hereby repealed.

8. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to this by-law, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
9. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
