THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 14-1181

Being a by-law to authorize the use of vote by mail for the 2014 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that a council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail or by telephone, that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote.

AND WHEREAS Council by resolution 14-086, passed on the 20th day of February 2014, deems it appropriate and in the public interest to use a vote by mail method in the 2014 Municipal Election;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the alternative voting method of "Vote by Mail" is hereby authorized for the Municipal Election to be held in 2014.
- 2. That in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, the Municipal Clerk shall establish procedures, rules and forms for the authorized alternative voting method.
- 3. That no proxy voting provisions shall be applicable for the Municipal Election conducted in accordance with this by-law.
- 4. That no advance voting provisions, other than Ballot Return Stations provided for in the procedures established in paragraph 2 of this by-law, shall be applicable for the Municipal Election conducted in accordance with this by-law.
- 5. That the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the necessary agreements to provide for the authorized alternative voting method.
- 6. That any person, corporation or trade union guilty of corrupt practices or contravening the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 or the procedures and rules as established in paragraph 2 of this by-law may be prosecuted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.
- 7. That By-law 2010-915 and any other previous by-laws, or parts thereof, that provide for alternate voting methods are hereby repealed.

- 8. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to this by-law, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
- 9. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
