

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 16-1299

**Being a by-law to amend By-law 16-1279, being a by-law to regulate the proceedings of the
Council of the Municipality of Temagami.**

WHEREAS under Section 238 (2), the Municipal Act, S.O., 2001, c.25, c.M. 45, as amended, requires every municipality and local board to pass a procedure by-law governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed Procedure By-law 16-1279 on the 25th day of February 2016;

AND WHEREAS Council passed Resolution 16-321 on the 9th day of June 2016 to consider an amendment to said by-law to put certain restrictions on unregistered delegations during an election;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the following wording be added to section 7.2: Delegations/Presentations - General:
“Despite any other provision of this Bylaw, no member of and no candidate for federal, provincial, or municipal government, or any person speaking on behalf of or concerning such candidate or their platform, shall be permitted to appear before Council or any Committee as a Delegation or Unregistered Presentation during the 12 months prior to which an election is required to be held or, in other instances, after an election has been called for the level of government in which that person is seeking election or re-election”;
2. That this By-law shall take effect upon the final passing thereof.
3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to this by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
