AND WHEREAS on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of February 2017 Council passe proposed wording for section 3.3 of Procedure By-law 16-127<sup>o</sup> direction to add a definition of "Council Liaison";

AND WHEREAS on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 2017, Co, pa^tohssed Resolution 17-187, to defer 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of this by-law until after a Committee of the<sup>7</sup> which meeting to decide the matter of what the Municipality is doing about committees, which means which means which means which means as held on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 2017;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the C enacts as follows:

- 1. That Procedure By-law 16-1279 is the ely amended by adding the following as section 1.7.1: "Council Liaison" shall mean the member of Council designated by by-law or resolution of Council to-bS the primary Member of Council on a committee, for the purpose of facilitating\Emfounication regarding decisions of the Council to the Committee and w^J? responsible for the reporting back to Council on recommendation of tyie Committee. The Council Liaison may be, but is not required to be, the comm^ ttab chair."
- 2. That Proced are y-law 16-1279 is hereby amended by deleting subsections 3.3 (b) to (f) and (h) and replacing them with the following:
  - bxW Vlayor shall disclose the results of that canvassing in a briefing note to Council and recommend a list of council portfolios that best reflects a balance of skills, preferences and the needs of the Municipality;
    - At the inaugural meeting, Council shall receive the Mayors recommendations and shall appoint by by-law the portfolios;
  - (d) The Mayor may, but shall not be required to, be the designated Council Liaison on a Committee;
  - (e) Every Councillor shall be required to be the designated Council Liaison on at least one Committee;
