

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI**

BY-LAW NO. 17-1330

**Being a by-law to amend By-law 16-1279, being a by-law to regulate the proceedings of the
Council of the Municipality of Temagami.**

WHEREAS under Section 238 (2), the Municipal Act, S.O., 2001, c.25, c.M. requires every municipality and local board to pass a procedure by-law governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami passed Procedure By-law 16-1279 on the 25th day of February 2016;

AND WHEREAS on the 2nd day of February 2017 Council passed Resolution 17-087, to approve proposed wording for section 3.3 of Procedure By-law 16-1279^o regarding council portfolios, with direction to add a definition of "Council Liaison";

AND WHEREAS on the 16th day of March 2017, Council passed Resolution 17-187, to defer 2nd reading of this by-law until after a Committee of the whole meeting to decide the matter of what the Municipality is doing about committees, which meeting was held on the 27th day of June 2017;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Procedure By-law 16-1279 is hereby amended by adding the following as section 1.7.1:
"Council Liaison" shall mean the member of Council designated by by-law or resolution of Council to be the primary Member of Council on a committee, for the purpose of facilitating communication regarding decisions of the Council to the Committee and who is responsible for the reporting back to Council on recommendations of the Committee. The Council Liaison may be, but is not required to be, the committee chair."
2. That Procedure By-law 16-1279 is hereby amended by deleting subsections 3.3 (b) to (f) and (h) and replacing them with the following:
 - (b) The Mayor shall disclose the results of that canvassing in a briefing note to Council and recommend a list of council portfolios that best reflects a balance of skills, preferences and the needs of the Municipality;
 - (c) At the inaugural meeting, Council shall receive the Mayor's recommendations and shall appoint by by-law the portfolios;
 - (d) The Mayor may, but shall not be required to, be the designated Council Liaison on a Committee;
 - (e) Every Councillor shall be required to be the designated Council Liaison on at least one Committee;
