

# THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 17-1345

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**Being a by-law to authorize the purchase the Briggs and Sisk landfill sites and the associated buffer zones from the Crown as represented by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry.**

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WHEREAS under Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the powers of a municipality shall be interpreted broadly to enable it to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami deems it desirable to purchase the Briggs and Sisk landfill sites and the associated buffer zones from the Crown as represented by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry;

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry has authorized a Crown easement for each of the leachate attenuation zones for the landfills;

**NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:**

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to purchase the Briggs and Sisk Landfill sites as shown on the Reference Plans 36R-13976 and 36R-13977 respectively;
2. That the sale price for the landfill footprint and associated buffer zone will be \$1000 plus HST (\$1130.00) for each site;
3. That the Municipality agrees to pay the one-time fee of \$1000 plus HST (\$1130.00) for each site for the leachate attenuation zone for each site to be authorized under a Crown easement;
4. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
5. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.

BE TAKEN AS READ A FIRST time on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 2017;

READ A SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 2017.
