

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

BY-LAW NO. 17-1357

**Being a by-law to authorize the execution of an agreement with the Minister of Infrastructure
for Clean Water and Wastewater (CWWF) Funding.**

WHEREAS under Section 8. (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25, as amended, the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS under Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25, as amended, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Temagami passed Resolution 16-484 on the 13th day of October 2016 to receive Memo 2016-M-061 regarding the Clean Water & Wastewater Fund (CWWF) Application and to authorize and direct staff to apply to the CWWF;

AND WHEREAS said funding has been granted in an amount up to \$137,308.36 for 75% funding (50% federal and 25% provincial) for Project # Tem-M 48069, subject to the entering into a contribution agreement with the Minister of Infrastructure;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this bylaw.
2. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
3. That the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.
