## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TEMAGAMI

## **BY-LAW NO. 24-1765**

Being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, Property Standards Officer,
Animal Control Officer and Municipal Weed Inspector

**WHEREAS** under Section 8 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., 2001, c.25, as amended, the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS**, Section 15 of the Police Services Act, R.S.O 1990, Chapter P. 15, provides that council of a municipality may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and such municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 1 of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O 1990, Chapter P.33 the Attorney General of Ontario has designated municipal law enforcement officers as provincial offences officers to enforce the by-laws of the municipality under the Provincial Offences Act;

**AND WHEREAS** the Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, c. 23 as amended, authorizes Council of a municipality to appoint a Property Standards Officer;

**AND WHEREAS** under section 6 (1) of the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.W.5, the council of every upper-tier and single-tier municipality shall by by-law appoint one or more persons as area weed inspectors to enforce this Act in the area within the council's jurisdiction;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Temagami hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Daryl Bell is hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, Property Standards Officer, Weed Inspector and Animal Control Officer for the Municipality of Temagami
- 2. THAT this appointment shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof
- 3. THAT any By-Law inconsistent with this By-Law is hereby repealed;
- 4. THAT the Clerk of the Municipality of Temagami is hereby authorized to make minor modifications or corrections of a grammatical or typographical nature to the by-law and schedule, after the passage of this by-law, where such modifications or corrections do not alter the intent of the by-law.

This By-Law be taken as read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 12th day of September, 2024
