Council Meeting Update – February 13, 2025

Temagami, ON – The Municipality of Temagami held its Second Regular Council Meeting of the year on February 13, 2025. Key topics discussed included infrastructure upgrades, community partnerships, and strategic planning.

Council approved the final version of the Municipality's Official Plan, marking a significant step in future land use and development planning. The updated plan provides a clear vision for growth while preserving Temagami's natural heritage and community character.

Representatives from Cogeco presented their plans to enhance internet access in Temagami through fibre installation. This investment aims to improve connectivity for residents and businesses, supporting local economic growth and digital accessibility.

Council approved a proposal from TULLOCH Engineering Inc. to conduct an inspection of Caribou Mountain. This review will ensure the ongoing safety and structural integrity of the site, a key attraction in the community.

Council authorized the initiation of a Development Charges Background Study to assess funding options for growth-related infrastructure improvements. This study will help determine fair and sustainable contributions from developers.

Council Supported the Following Community Groups and Initiatives; Sisters by Choice, Deep Water Music Festival, and the Ling Fling Fishing Event.

Council approved several by-laws, including the Employment Policy & Procedures Manual, Parkland Dedication By-law, Forest Fire Management Agreement, Municipal Auditor Appointment

Council plans to engage with the School Board regarding local education concerns and explore the potential implementation of a Municipal Accommodation Tax (MAT).
